

Car Parking, Dropping Off & Child Collection Policy

Rum Tum Tugger's Nursery has the benefit of dedicated car parking spaces. This is in the main school car park and are situated at the back of the car park. It is our policy that all parent/carers and visitors make use of designated parking, leaving their vehicles safely and without causing a hazard to other users and neighbours. If the car park is full you will need to park outside of the main gates and walk your child into nursery. Please do not double park within the carpark.

You must not park on the yellow "zig zags" outside the nursery, as this is used as an "Exit" path in the event of a fire.

You must hold your child's hand while in the car park as cars are constantly coming in and out of the facility. Once outside of the building your child is your responsibility. This includes ensuring that they are safely and appropriately restrained in your car in a car seat that is correct for their age height and weight. Children who are not appropriately secure may be reported to the relevant authorities.

When dropping a child off, please bring them right inside the nursery building and remain with them until they have been registered by a member of staff.

Only those people named on a child's enrolment papers will be allowed to collect a child. Children will not be released in to the care of siblings under the age of 18 unless express permission is obtained from the company directors. In cases of emergency, a parent/carer must notify a member of the nursery management of any changes to these arrangements. A secure password must be quoted prior to the child being released to an unknown carer.
